Sharps Drop Off

Placing medical sharps in the trash or recycling bins poses a serious safety risk to sanitation and recycling workers. Sharps may be disposed of at the drop off sites listed below during regular business hours.

Medical Sharps should be placed into a red biohazard "Sharps" container.

"Sharps" containers come in a variety of shapes and sizes, and are available at many local pharmacies and medical supply outlets.

Sharps containers are also offered free of charge to residents at HWMA's office in Eureka while supplies last

Medication Drop Off Locations

Follow these easy steps:

- At home, remove, scratch off or black-out personal information from the containers to protect your identity.
- Remove pills from the original container, place in a clear zippy bag, and recycle the container.
- Keep liquids and creams in original containers.
- Bring medications to any of the listed drop off sites.

What can I drop off?

- Prescription medications-only certain locations accept Controlled Substances.
- Over-the-Counter medications.
- Medicated ointments and lotions.
- Pet medications.

What is not accepted in drop off bins?

- Sharps (hypodermic needles, syringes, lancets and auto injectors)
- Dietary Supplements, Vitamins.
- Business waste (Product samples, doctor's, dentist's, and veterinary waste).
